MSSA Target Payment is due on or before the first qualifying Skeet lesson. Total payment of \$ 150.00 is to be made payable to MSSA on your cheque. 12ga. or 20 ga. Semi-Auto or an O/U barreled shotgun required, loaner shotgun is accessible. Skeet Juniors will get 50% Free Targets on Monday evenings, PLUS 50 Free Targets on Sunday Noon instruction on Skeet Field # 4. MSSA Junior Olympic Skeet Program with advance registration is required. NO REFUNDS from the MSSA after 1st Junior Skeet Level 1 lesson of skeet target shooting instruction. To shoot the Junior Olympic Skeet on Sundays, you must have completed FIVE of the Monday's Junior Skeet NSSA Level 1 lessons in succession with qualifying target ranking.
